What is financial aid?

Federal – FAFSA

 $\overline{NYS} - TAP$

- Scholarships free money, meet specific criteria, competitive
- -Grants free money, usually financial need is required
- **Loans** money that must be paid back
- **Work study campus job to earn money for college expenses**
- -Family

Who completes the forms?

- -Parents' AND student information is required.
- For divorce or separation situations, the parent with whom the student resides completes the forms if remarried, step-parent also reports income.
- For joint custody situations, the parent who provides the most support completes the form.

Dependence VS Independence


- In most cases, students <u>under 24</u> will be required to report parent information.
- A section of the FAFSA will provide options for students younger than 24 that <u>MAY</u> qualify as independent.
- For other special circumstances, consult with the financial aid office.

Before Starting the FAFSA

Students and parents need to create their own Federal Student Aid ID (FSA ID).

- ~ Used to access features and sign FAFSA electronically.
- ~ Can create an ID at studentaid.gov.


Creating the FSA ID


- **Do not pay to fill out the FAFSA—IT'S FREE!!**



IRS Data Retrieval Tool

Using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (DRT) to LINK TO IRS

Go to www.fafsa.gov, access your 2021-2022 FAFSA, and make a correction on the Financial Information section

The following step-by-step instructions illustrate how to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool (DRT) to link tax information to a student's FAFSA. Please note the following directions are for the parent(s)' financial information. If the student wishes to link his or her tax information, the option will be available after the parent's financial data is completed. If the student is indepdent for FAFSA purposes, only student financial data will display, and the student will be given the option to "Link to IRS," similar to the instructions below.



- Connects to IRS for tax data of completed tax returns
- Use for original FAFSA and corrections

NYS Tuition Assistance Program

- If possible, immediately after submitting the FAFSA, apply for TAP. There will be a link from your confirmation page on the FAFSA.
- Need-based, up to \$5,665/year.
- This is a grant and does not need to be paid back!
- Can only list one college to receive information.

What Happens Next

- Your school(s) will contact you if they need more information or when they are ready to discuss your financial aid award.

- Used by some private colleges
- Non-Federal Aid Application

When do I apply for Financial Aid?

OCTOBER 1, 2021!

CHECK COLLEGE FINANCIAL AID DEADLINES!

If you are selected for verification?

- Some people are selected at random; and some schools verify all students' FAFSAs.
- Simply provide the documentation your school asks for before their deadline or you won't be able to get financial aid.

What happens after I apply?

- You will receive a *Student Aid Report* (SAR) within three days to three weeks after you submit the FAFSA.
- The SAR is a summary of the information you submitted.
- Check your SAR carefully for mistakes.
- If you need to make corrections login to fafsa.gov and make corrections there!

Understanding Award Letters

Award letter video

Colleges generate an award letter only AFTER a student completes the FAFSA and financial aid process!

Award Letter Comparison Tool

- Make sure you understand what is being offered!
- Students can accept or decline any type of financial aid offered!
- Typically, must sign and accept award package offered – keep track of deadlines!

Cost of Attendance ~

Direct costs

+ <u>Indirect costs</u>Cost of Attendance

Expected Family Contribution ~

Family's financial information is used to calculate the student's **EFC**.

The **EFC** is **not** the amount of money your family will have to pay for college **nor** is it the amount of federal student aid you will receive. It is an estimate of the parents' and/or student's ability to pay.

Higher Education Opportunity Program (HEOP/EOP)

- For educationally and economically disadvantaged students.
- Must meet academic and economic guidelines.
- Provides funding and academic services to increase college success.

Other Sources of Financial Aid

- Scholarships from colleges/universities.
- Generally awarded on an annual basis. Some are renewable.
- Sources of scholarships unlimited!
- Check Guidance Scholarship page for updated scholarship list. Examples:

 - Northern Federal Credit Union
