


ERIK HONDUSKY

Erik Hondusky was a dedicated husband to his wife Raylene, father to his son Brandon and grandfather to his granddaughter Madison. He was also very dedicated volunteer in his community. Erik served for over 35 years with the Massena Volunteer Rescue Squad, where he held the offices of President, 1st Assistant Chief and 3rd Assistant Chief. He also volunteered with Helena Fire & Rescue where he served as Safety Officer for 7 years. He took this job very seriously and always had his eye out for everyone's safety. Erik also joined BACA (Bikers Against Child Abuse). He enjoyed riding his motorcycle and helping children. Erik was a huge proponent of trade or tech schools, having gone to TCI in East Windsor, CT himself, becoming a HVAC tech. Throughout his life Erik set an example of sacrifice, hard work, dedication, service to community, and leadership.
